Overweight Permit Conditions
 General

- The vehicle and/or load is considered to be indivisible, when all reasonable measures have been taken to minimize the extent to which the vehicle or load exceeds the normal dimensional limits. Reasonable measures are considered to include use of appropriate equipment, such as low bed trailers for over length loads, extendable trailers for over length loads, and proper orientation of load.
- Permit non-transferable from vehicle to vehicle. Permit may be revoked, cancelled, or recalled at anytime.
- Permit must be in the vehicle when operated on the highway, and provided to a Peace Officer on request.
- Valid from sunrise to sunset (daylight hours only)**
